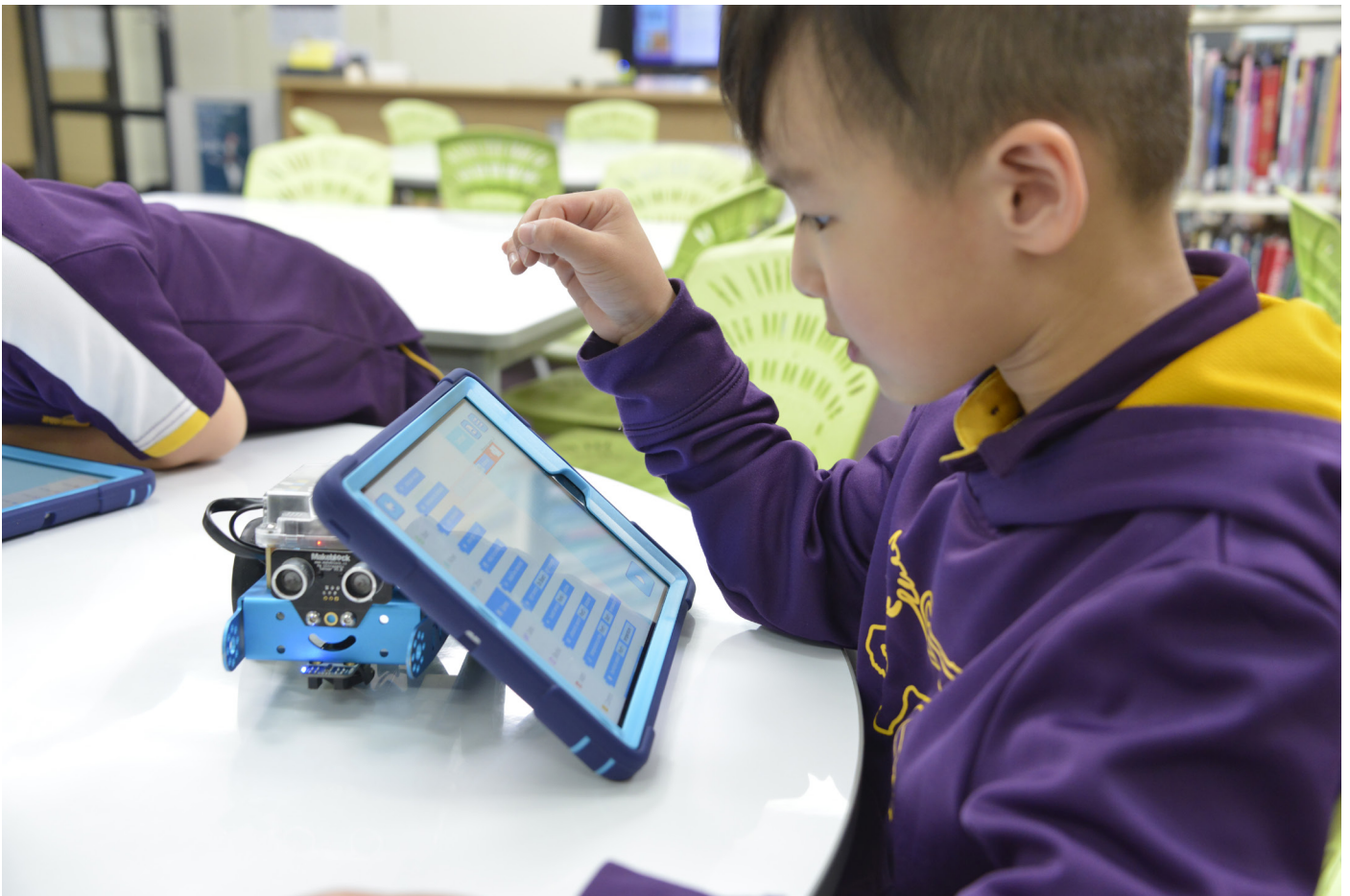
Code Camp After School

Enrolments

All students who are not collected by their parents from their after school class will be taken to the Extend Aftercare program. As this is run by an external provider, we encourage all children to be registered with them, in the event you are late in collecting your child.
