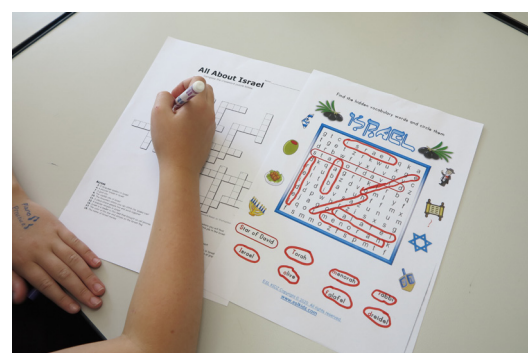
Jewish Life Program

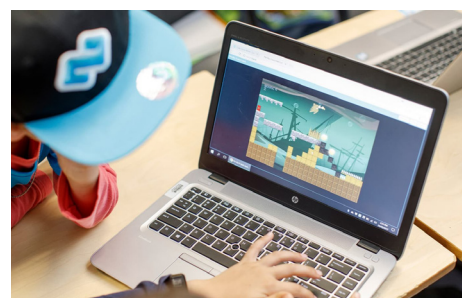
