



## Wesley College Melbourne **College Council Charter**

Purpose	• Governing body responsible for ensuring the charitable object of providing early learning, primary and secondary education.
Authority to Act	<ul> <li>Appointed in accordance with the Constitution of Wesley College Melbourne to manage the business and affairs of the College</li> </ul>
Composition	<ul> <li>No fewer than ten (10) nor more than twelve (12) including Office Bearers, and the Principal</li> <li>Office Bearers are the President, Deputy President and the Chair of FARM (Finance Audit and Risk Management Committee)</li> <li>Appointment as a Councillor, and re-appointment, is governed by the Constitution</li> <li>Council may, on advice of the Nominations Committee, appoint one or more persons to be co-opted members of Council and/or Council committees (other than Nominations) for an initial term of one (1) year. A co-opted member to Council cannot vote on Council resolutions</li> </ul>
Conduct of Meetings	<ul> <li>No less than six (6) times during each year and in accordance with the Constitution</li> <li>Invitees In Attendance (monthly): Business Director &amp; Chief Financial Officer</li> <li>Invitees Guests (as required): Other staff, external Auditor</li> <li>Minutes of all proceedings of General Meeting and Council meetings, including meetings of Council committees, are to be kept</li> </ul>
Key Responsibilities	<ul> <li>Governing body for Wesley College Melbourne (Victoria)</li> <li>Achievement of the Objects of the College as contained in the Constitution</li> <li>Appointment of the Principal on such terms and conditions as the Council determines</li> <li>Confirmation of the appointment of a Chief Financial Officer</li> <li>Appointment of a suitably qualified auditor in accordance with the Constitution</li> <li>Holding an annual general meeting to elect the Councillors and to receive and consider the Annual Accounts, the balance sheet and reports of Council and the Auditor</li> <li>In conjunction with the Principal approve the strategic and educational plans and monitor their implementation</li> <li>Review and endorse significant operating policies and procedures prepared by the Principal for the College</li> <li>Approve the annual College budget and monitor financial performance</li> <li>Approve annually the Delegation of Authorities</li> </ul>
